Roger gave the Ecom trailer report: He has been working on the fender, fitting them to match. They are close to that, but won't be perfect, but will be close. He will get back with us regarding the final costs. He wants to have permission to take the trailer to upcoming Races on June 17th and August 26th. 146.850, Dickinson County. He was granted permission. He then asked to use for the LARS Yoooper Newberry Hamfest on June 10th this year. That was granted as well.
